## **2024 NHDES INTERNSHIP GUIDELINES**

Internship opportunities with the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services are available for students in the sciences, engineering, computer science, business, education, journalism, media, public relations and all others. Depending upon qualifications and job placement, the salary will begin at \$15.62 hourly. Interns may complete assignments in any of the following areas:

- A diverse range of environmental or engineering field assignments which may include sampling, data collection, surveying, assessments, work in or around water, or field inspections at regulated facilities.
- Interacting with the general public and the regulated community, providing information on health, safety, compliance and environmental issues.
- Working with volunteer and community groups, providing training and support of environmental monitoring initiatives.
- Assessing the impact of invasive species and mitigation measures.
- Assisting with publications, public relations, outreach, and education efforts.
- Completing a broad range of accounting assignments.
- Assisting with permits, applications and rulemaking.
- Assisting with surveying, scanning of engineering plans and dam maintenance.
- Providing administrative assistance and with the creation of legal documents.
- Entering and interpreting data, compiling reports, analysis and maps, including work with GIS and GPS.

**Commitment:** Duration depends upon job assignments, varying between 12 to 24 weeks. The majority of opportunities will be from mid-May through August.
